Bigger, bolder Beethoven with The Florida Orchestra

When the largest professional orchestra in Florida revs up in the fall, it will offer a rare chance to experience Beethoven at his boldest. The Florida Orchestra will perform the supersized Mahler arrangements of both Beethoven's Fifth and Eroica Symphony as it celebrates the 250th anniversary of the composer's birth.

TFO has never played the Mahler versions before. How are they different? Often called "Beethoven on steroids," both are the original symphonies, with a few tweaks, performed by an orchestra much larger than Beethoven could have ever imagined. Audiences will get all the familiar beauty of Beethoven, but with awe-inspiring power. Beethoven's Fifth and Eroica Symphony are among the 10 or so Beethoven works on TFO's schedule for the 2019-2020 season. Others include his third and fourth piano concertos, his violin concerto and his fourth and eighth symphonies.

"Beethoven is the greatest composer because he took all that life threw at him and turned it into inspirational art that still unites humanity today," says Music Director Michael Francis, who is programming all of Beethoven's symphonies and major concertos over two seasons in honor of the composer. "We'll use Beethoven as a framework to explore deeper issues of his life and music, such as perseverance, hope and heroism. Then we'll ask: Who are the Beethovens of today? Who are the people reflecting our society through music?"

But the Masterworks series isn't all about Beethoven. In another first, TFO welcomes superstar American composer and conductor Eric Whitacre in November for Deep Field: A Cosmic Experience, which also will mark the 50th anniversary of the moon landing, with stunning Hubble Telescope video and The Master Chorale of Tampa Bay singing in the aisles. Other highlights include Vivaldi's The Four Seasons directed by TFO Concertmaster Jeffrey Multer on violin; Mozart's Clarinet Concerto with TFO Principal Clarinet Natalie Hoe; Rachmaninoff's Piano Concerto No. 3 with Joyce Yang; and the Rascher Saxophone Quartet performing a piece by modern American master Philip Glass.





Dakota Ave., Cork

Ave., and Inman Ave. all intersected near where the British pay phone sits today. The only portion left of Cork

Ave. today is called Snow Ave. Hyde Park Village today is a charming area with locally-owned and national boutiques and restaurants.
