

eatured on the hit television show, Animal Planet, ZooTampa is a lush 65 acre tropical habitat that's home to more than 1,300 exotic animals. Divided into six distinct areas with

Interactive exhibits that

literally take you around the world, the zoo also includes lots of fun rides as well as a special Splash Pad area (bring your bathing suits) where you and the

kids can cool your jets.

First up is the Manatee Circle anchored by a beautiful Manatee Fountain which is a perfect place for photo ops.

Just next door is the Asia section where you can go nose-to-horn with

an Indian Rhino and hang out with a hulking Komodo dragon, laid back sloth bear and clouded leopard.

Love manatees? At the David A Straz, Jr Manatee Hospital, the Zoo's veterinary and animal-care staff treat sick, injured and orphaned manatees before returning them to the wild after rehabilitation. There's also a Stingray Feeding area here which is pretty darn cool.

Walk over to the Africa area and you'll feel like you

were teleported to a village in the Savannah where giraffes, zebras, elephants, rhinos, and other native species meander about.

Want to get even closer? Just hop on the Safari Tram for a behind the scenes ride. FYI: Don't be surprised to

see baby elephants frolicking in the mud to stay cool.

The beach is always better with a little Brahms and Beethoven. The Florida Orchestra has announced its new 2024-25 season celebrating 10 years of Music Director Michael Francis, featuring epic masterpieces alongside a wide variety of popular, film, jazz music and more. Now is the time to include a world-class concert with the largest professional orchestra in Florida, based in Tampa Bay.
