# The Florida Orchestra keeps the music playing

ven without live concerts, The Florida Orchestra will not let the music be silenced. Since the coronavirus pandemic took hold in mid-March, the orchestra has posted more than 100 free performance and education videos straight from musicians' homes to yours in its TFO at Home series.

This robust online series is powered by the orchestra's 67 full-time professional musicians, led by Music Director Michael Francis and Associate Conductor Daniel Black, and includes several virtual orchestra performances such as Elgar's Pomp and Circumstance for the Class of 2020, a series of videos digging deeper into Beethoven's Symphony No. 7, and an uplifting version of Tchaikovsky's Symphony No. 4 (finale). All available at FloridaOrchestra.org/TFO-at-Home.

"We chose the end of the finale of Tchaikovsky's Symphony No. 4 because of its brilliant optimism," Maestro Francis said. "Even though the symphony begins in darkness and fear, by the end a glorious celebration of hope shines through. It is exhilaration unleashed!"

TFO at Home also includes links to live recordings of TFO concerts available to stream on demand through Classical WSMR.org, concert preview videos by Maestro Francis, blog posts and a virtual learning section with dozens of

videos to help strings students and teachers practice and learn at home.

As a vibrant part of Tampa Bay for more than 52 years, The Florida Orchestra quickly adapted to serve the community with music during the pandemic. The orchestra's history started more than five decades ago on a boat in the middle of Tampa Bay, when the St. Petersburg Symphony and the Tampa Philharmonic came together in a "marriage" ceremony. Now TFO has grown into the premier – and largest – professional orchestra in the state. It is the only performing arts organization that bridges the entire bay area, with concerts in Tampa, St. Petersburg and Clearwater.

Michael Francis took over in the fall of 2015 as the orchestra's fourth





music director, and he will enter his sixth season with TFO in the fall with a contract extension through the 2023/24 season. The maestro has quickly established himself as one of the leading international conductors of today. With the start of the 2019/20 season, Francis began his tenure as chief conductor of Deutsche Staatsphilharmonie Rheinland-Pfalz. He has been music director of the Mainly Mozart Festival in San Diego since 2014 and was chief conductor and artistic advisor of the Norrköping Symphony Orchestra from 2012 to 2016.

Music has the immense power to

bring us together and light us with joy. With TFO's vast, flexible reach throughout Tampa Bay, the orchestra is determined to play a key role in unifying and healing the Tampa Bay community. With everyone's safety a top priority, The Florida Orchestra is preparing fall concerts filled with the triumphant and inspirational music we all love. The orchestra will continue to provide music any way they can, with passion, beauty and strength.

# The Florida Orchestra gives suffrage song new life

Inspired by the 100th anniversary of women's right to vote this year, The Florida Orchestra and The Master Chorale of Tampa Bay brought together about 50 musicians for a virtual performance of the 19th century anthem Daughters of Freedom, delivering a message of perseverance, hope and unity amid the coronavirus pandemic.

Accomplished composer and TFO Associate Conductor Daniel Black was already working on an original arrangement of the anthem for concerts this summer when the pandemic hit.

"Obviously, there are a lot of differences between a 50-year struggle for the cause of women's suffrage and the current pandemic, but one thing I find in common is the need for resilience and perseverance. This music speaks powerfully to that need," Black said.

He used a simple vocal score from the Library of Congress to create the three-minute arrangement for orchestra and voice for Daughters of Freedom, a prominent march song during the movement. Obscure composer Edwin Christie wrote the original in 1871, with lyrics by George Cooper.

Black sent the music digitally to musicians, who recorded their parts individually at home using smartphones and other devices. They also used a "click track" to keep an even tempo so Black could pull all the individual tracks together into one seamless piece.

You can see the finished video as part of the orchestra's TFO at Home series, which is keeping the music going online through musician videos and more at FloridaOrchestra.org/TFO-at-Home.

Black hopes the video is a good reminder of the cultural riches in Tampa Bay.

"I hope this video will show Tampa
Bay that our premier performing arts
organizations are still here. We are still
making music, and we are still a part of the
community. With courage and determination,
together we will get through this."

# 13 FAST RECIPES FOR INSPIRED ENTERTAINING

ou don't have to hire a professional chef or be a great cook to throw a great party. With a little shopping, a little effort and 20 minutes or less for assembly, you can create the kind of carry-out food that will put the local food shops to shame all the while saving you a small fortune!

Here are just some of our favorite quickies from Mark Bittman of the NY Times:

#### Grapes & Cheese

Mix feta cubes and green grapes (can also substitute grape tomatoes or pieces of watermelon). Add mint, salt, pepper and

### Roasted Red Pepper Dip

some olive oil.

Puree roasted red peppers (jarred are OK) with feta, marjoram or oregano and parsley, olive oil and garlic. Serve with pita chips.

### Ultimate Stuffed Celery

Process a cup or two of cashews, a chili or two, some garlic, a splash of soy sauce and enough water to get the food processor going; fold in chopped cilantro or chives ,fill celery sticks and chill. This

> is the best celery filler since cream cheese!

#### Cornflake Chicken

Cut boneless chicken breasts into small pieces. Dip in milk or buttermilk

then dredge in seasoned crushed corn

flake crumbs, cornmeal or panko. Pan-fry in oil, drain, cool and eat cold with celery sticks and ranch or blue cheese dressing for dipping.

#### Beet Salad

Grate cooked beets. Add pistachio or hazlenuts; dress with orange zest and juice and olive oil. Add bits of goat cheese and chopped parsely.

#### Tomatoes & Peaches

Toss together sliced seeded tomatoes and peaches, along with thinly sliced red onion and chopped cilantro or rosemary. Dress at last minute with olive oil, lemon juice, salt & pepper.

#### Roast Beef & Blue

Start with whole grain rolls. Smear blue cheese on one side and horseradish on the other. Add red onion

and thin-sliced roast beef. Serve with lettuce and tomato on the side.

### Thai Gazpacho

Combine two pounds of ripe tomatoes, one pound of cucumbers in a blender with lemon grass (only the most tender part), cilantro, fish sauce and lime. Chill and serve.

#### Pesto Chicken Rolls

Season and grill chicken cutlets. Brush Lavash or any other type of wrap-type bread with pesto; layer with the chicken, sun-dried tomatoes and arugula. Roll up and cut in half on the bias.



#### Zesty Corn

Brown fresh corn kernels in hot oil with chopped chili and garlic, salt and pepper. Remove from heat and toss with a generous amount of cilantro and lots of fresh lime juice. Yum-meee!

#### Cucumber & Chicken

Cut one or two cucumbers in half; scoop out the seeds. Slice thin, salt and set aside for 5 minutes. Squeeze out some of the liquid. Combine cucumber with with shredded cooked chicken, some fresh ginger, soy, salt, pepper and cilantro. On a baguette, it's reminiscent of banh mi.

#### Asian Noodles

Cook rice vermicelli and drain. Toss

with Kimchi, lots of cilantro and cooked shrimp or chicken

#### Pasta Toss

Cook fusilli or other cut pasta; rinse in cool water but don't bother to chill. Combine with chopped, seeded tomatoes, cubed fresh mozzarella, chopped basil, olive oil, salt and pepper. Do not call this pasta



Just next door is the Harn Museum of Art - one of the country's largest university owned art museums.

The Harn's impressive collection totals more than 10,000 objects including an extensive collection of Asian Art, as well as modern and contemporary art, photography and more.

For foodies, Gainesville's vibrant downtown delivers a plethora of excellent local restaurants that range from sushi to steak to everything in between. After dark, lively nightclubs and a professional theater keep things even more



## Cedar Key Clam Linguine

hef Robin Draper, Authentic Florida After a road trip to Cedar Key, home to a thriving aquaculture clam business, Robin Draper was inspired to make this delicious linguine with fresh Florida clams. Available in most seafood markets, they are sweet and super delicious.

#### Ingredients

(Yield 4 servings)

Olive Oil

2 Cups Chopped Yellow Onion

1-1/2 Cups Chopped Red Bell

Pepper

6 Garlic Cloves, minced

1/2 Cup White Wine

1 Tbs Dried Lemon Pepper

1 Tbs Dried Oregano

2 Tbs Fresh Parsley

3 Dozen Fresh Clams\*

(recommend 8-10 per person)

4 Cans Minced Clams (preferably

Snow's in clam juice)

1 Lb Package Linguine pasta

1/3 Cup Fresh Grated Parmigiano-

Reggiano Cheese

2 Tbs Salt

Red Pepper Flakes to taste

\*NOTE: Any other small clams can be substituted if you cannot find Cedar Key clams.

#### **Preparation**

In a large sauté pan, heat (medium heat) the olive oil, sauté onion and pepper and soften for 10 minutes. Add garlic and sauté for 1-2 minutes (don't let the garlic burn). Add the lemon pepper, dried oregano, 1 tbsp of the parsley and white wine. Cook for 5-10 minutes to absorb

the wine. Add minced clams AND the juice.

Bring mixture to a boil and then lower to medium heat — do not cover with a lid. Reduce the

original sauce by ½ to



create a more concentrated flavor. It will take around 30 minutes. In the meantime, using a colander, rinse/scrub the clams. Next bring 4 quarts of water to a boil for linguine pasta. Add salt. Cook uncovered for 10 minutes or until desired tenderness. Remove from heat and drain in colander. After the clam mixture is reduced — almost to  $\frac{1}{2}$  — add fresh clams into the sauce. Keep cooking at medium heat with the lid on. The clams will open gradually — around 20 minutes. Throw away any clams that do not open. Add the final 1 Tbs of parsley along with a few pinches of red pepper flakes and salt to taste.

#### To Serve

Place a 1/4 portion of the drained pasta on each plate. Scoop the fresh clam sauce with clams and pour over the pasta. Serve with fresh Parmesan and extra bowls for discarding clam shells.
