

The Florida Orchestra celebrates America and beyond

Get the full Florida experience with an uplifting concert by the state's largest professional orchestra. The Florida Orchestra has announced its new 2023-24 season celebrating America's great music and beyond, and now is the time to include a world-class concert in your plans.

Inspired by the 100th anniversary of Gershwin's groundbreaking Rhapsody in Blue, Music Director Michael Francis is featuring a wide range of American composers from Aaron Copland to Wynton Marsalis alongside global masterpieces from Beethoven, Tchaikovsky, Mozart, Dvorak and more. In September, he launches the premier Hough Family Foundation Masterworks series with a bang: Holst's The Planets paired with the thrilling Percussion Collective.

Big moments in the Masterworks series include Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue (Feb. 17 & 18, 2024), Copland's Appalachian Spring (Oct. 21 & 22), Dvorak's New World Symphony (April 12-14, 2024), based on American spirituals while Dvorak lived in the United States; Beethoven's heroic Eroica Symphony

(April 5-7, 2024); Tchaikovsky's Symphony No. 6 (Jan. 19 & 20, 2024) and Elgar's Enigma Variations (May 17-19, 2024). The series wraps up with Mahler's epic Symphony No. 2, "Resurrection" (May 25 & 26, 2024), which features the Master Chorale of Tampa Bay.

For the first time, all 13 Masterworks concerts will include a surprise, unlisted "mystery piece" personally chosen by Maestro Francis. "We've put a lot of thought into each short piece, which will enhance the concert in an unexpected and memorable way and reveal something new. They will make you smile," Francis said.

In the Raymond James Pops series, the circus meets the symphony in Cirque Dances with Troupe Vertigo (Oct. 7 & 8), in addition to Twist & Shout (March 1, 2024), a tribute to 60 years of The Beatles in America; a supersonic Sci-Fi Spectacular (Jan. 13 & 14, 2024) of stellar hits from TV and movies, such as Avatar, The Mandalorian, Star Wars and more; and the very merry tradition of Holiday Pops (Dec. 15-17).





Tampa's Very Own "Cigar City" Historic Ybor City



id you know that when you're in Tampa you can make a side trip to Cuba without needing a passport?

Conveniently located just northeast of downtown Tampa, Ybor City (pronounced EE-BOR), is home to a genuine piece of Cuban territory – José Martí Park. The park at the corner of 8th Avenue and 13th Street is actually owned by the people of Cuba. For nearly six decades, it was the only piece of Cuban-owned land in the United States until 2015 when the Cuban Embassy opened in Washington, DC.

The park's namesake, José Martí, was a poet, journalist, and firebrand who led the island's revolution against Spanish rule in the 1880s and 1890s. Martí lived in exile for many years as he fought for his homeland's freedom. During that time, he often visited Tampa Bay, where thousands of Cuban cigar rollers and Spanish factory owners like Vicente Martinez Ybor – the neighborhood's founder, provided essential moral and financial support to Martí and his cause.

Now considered the Cigar Capital of the World, Ybor City is the only neighborhood on Florida's West Coast that is designated as a National Historic Landmark District. Its main commercial thoroughfare, 7th Avenue, has also been recognized as one of the "10 Great Streets in America."

Today, a walk down 7th Avenue is truly a walk through the history. In the 1880s, Ybor City was a melting pot of immigrants from Spain, Cuba, Germany and Italy and home to some of the world's most famous cigar factories that were the main economic source for the city. At one point, Ybor boasted 200 factories that produced more than 500 million cigars a year, earning the community the nickname "Cigar City."

Since then, many of the factory warehouses have been converted into business lofts, restaurants, shops and more. Ybor City has now evolved into Tampa's Latin Quarter, offering a full menu of arts, culture, nightclubs and entertainment. Through it all, Cuban torcedores still make hand-rolled cigars in shops along Seventh Avenue as they have since those early days. If you plan to be in the Tampa area any time soon, be sure to visit historic Ybor and take in the sights, smells and culture of this fascinating area. To find out more, go to YborCityOnline.com.

- 2 Tsp Vanilla Extract

- 1 Cup Whole Milk

PREPARATION

Gather 10 cast irons and spray with pan spray. Add crushed pineapple to the bottoms just enough to cover and put a cherry in the center of each one. Add together the butter, sugar and vanilla in a large bowl. Using a whisk attachment, a mix together on medium speed until



all ingredients are thoroughly combined (approximately 4 - 5 minutes). Once incorporated, turn
